Eligibility Criteria for MS/ M.Phil & Ph.D Admission Fall-2021

Faculty of Engineering & Technology

MS/ M.Sc. Programs: Civil, Computer Systems, Electrical, Energy System, Mechanical and Software Engineering:

Eligibility:

Must have passed B.Sc. Engineering in relevant field with 65% marks in semester system and 50% marks in annual system of examination and no 3rd division in the academic record, GAT by NTS qualifying score as per the HEC requirements/ M-GAT (conducted by MUST) and duly registered with the Pakistan Engineering Council.

For Energy System Engineering (This program is offered by Mechanical Engineering Department):

Must have passed B.Sc. Engineering in Mechanical, Electrical, Civil, Environmental or Chemical with 65% marks in semester system and 50% marks in annual system of examination and no 3rd division in the academic record. GAT by NTS qualifying score as per the HEC requirements/ M-GAT (conducted by MUST) and duly registered with the Pakistan Engineering Council.

Ph.D Programs: Civil, Electrical, and Mechanical:

Eligibility:

Must have passed M.Sc. Engineering in relevant field with at least CGPA 3.0/4.0 or CGPA 3.50/5.0 (at least 65% marks) in semester system and 1st Division (60% marks) in annual system of Examination, GAT (Subject)/ NTS/ International GRE (Subject) with minimum 60%marks, no 3rd division in the academic record and duly registered with Pakistan Engineering Council.

Mirpur Institute of Technology (MIT)

MS Programs: Electrical Engineering Technology

Eligibility:

Must have passed 16-years of education in B.Sc. (Engineering Technology) /B.Sc. (Technology) / B-Tech (4 Years) degree program with 65% marks in semester system and 50% marks in annual system of examination and no 3rd division in the academic record. GAT (General) by NTS qualifying score as per HEC requirements and duly registered with National Technology Council (NTC).

Faculty of Natural & Applied Science

MS/ M.Phil Programs: **Biotechnology**, **Botany**, **Chemistry**, **Computer Science**, **Mathematics**, **Physics and Zoology**:

Eligibility:

Must have passed M.Sc./ BS (4 years) with at least 65% marks in semester system and 50% marks in annual system of examination in the relevant discipline with no 3rd division in the academic record. GAT by NTS with minimum 50% cumulative score.

For Biotechnology:

Must have passed M.Sc./ BS (4 years) with at least 65% marks in semester system and 50% marks in annual system of examination in Biotechnology/ Biology/ Bio-Chemistry/ Botany/ Zoology/ Bio-informatics/ Molecular Biology/ Pharm-D/ Medical Lab Technology/ DVM or Agriculture Science with no 3rd division in the academic record. GAT by NTS with minimum 50% cumulative score.

Ph.D Programs: Biotechnology, Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Physics and Zoology:

Eligibility:

Must have passed M.Phil with at least 65% marks in the respective discipline with GAT (Subject) NTS/ GRE (Subject) as per the HEC requirements.

For Biotechnology:

Must have passed M.Phil in 1st division or CGPA 3.0/4.0 in Biotechnology/ Biology/ Bio-Chemistry/ Botany/ Zoology/ Molecular Biology/ Bio-informatics/ Agriculture Science or Pharmacy with GAT (Subject)/ GRE (Subject) as per the HEC requirements.

Faculty of Social Science & Humanities

MS/ M.Phil Programs: Economics, Education and Islamic Studies:

Eligibility:-

For Economics and Islamic Studies: Must have passed 16-years of education with at least 65% marks in semester system and 50% marks in annual system of examination in relevant discipline with no 3rd division in the academic record. GAT by NTS with minimum 50% cumulative score.

For Education: Must have passed M.A Education/ M.Ed./ B.Ed. Elementary (4 years.)/ BS Education with at least 65% marks in semester system and 50% marks in annual system of examination with no 3rd division in the academic record. GAT by NTS with minimum 50% cumulative score.

MS Programs: Management Sciences

Eligibility:-

Must have passed BBA/B.Com (4 years)/MBA or equivalent and relevant degree with at least 65% marks in semester system and 50% marks in annual system of examination with no 3rd division in the academic record. GAT by NTS with minimum 50% cumulative score.
